## **STARTS JANUARY 15**

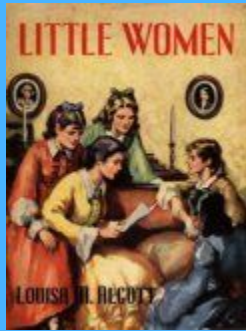
